About Pune

Pune, a historic city, is popularly known as the cultural and education capital of Maharashtra state in India. It is also recognized as a hub for automobile and IT industries. It is home to numerous educational and research institutes of repute, including National Chemical Laboratory, National Centre for Cell Sciences, National Institute of Virology, National Aids Research

Institute, Agharkar Research Institute, Center for Development of Advanced Computing, Inter University Center for Astronomy and Astrophysics, National Centre for Radio Astrophysics, Institute of Science Education and Research and many more.

Climate and Clothing

Climate in Pune during early December would be pleasant. Days would be warm with maximum temperature of about 28 degrees Celsius and nights would be cooler with a minimum temperature of about 10 degrees Celsius. Cottons during the day and light woollens during evening/night are recommended.

How to Reach

Pune is well connected by air, road and rail network.

Air

Pune has direct flights to and from many domestic as well as some international destinations. Pune airport is located at Lohegaon at a distance of 18 kms from the Savitribai Phule Pune University Campus. The Chhatrapati Shivaji International Airport at Mumbai is about 175 kms (110 miles) away and it takes about 3.5 hrs to reach Pune from Mumbai through express way. Registered AC cabs also run between Mumbai airport and Pune.

Rail

There are daily and weekly trains connecting Pune to all major cities in India including Mumbai, New Delhi, Chennai, Kolkata, Bangalore, Hyderabad, Ahmadabad and many more.

Road

Pune is well connected by a good road network connecting it to various cities and towns across the India. Various government as well as private agencies offer daily bus services to various destinations in the state of Maharashtra and the neighboring states. OLA, UBER, K K Travels and Cool cabs (Registered taxis) run between Pune and Mumbai.

Travel within the city

OLA/UBER cabs and metered auto rickshaws (three wheelers) can be hired for travel within the city. The state-run city bus services are also available, but may be crowded many a times. The organizers would make travel arrangement from the place of accommodation to the conference venue.

Sight seeing

Numerous places of historical, ecological, religious and cultural importance are located in and around Pune. The sites of interest in the city include Shaniwarwada, Kelkar Museum, Aga Khan Palace, Khatraj Zoological Park, Parvati, etc. **Places of tourists' interest around Pune include the following:**

World heritage sites

Ajanta and Ellora caves (near Aurangabad), Elephanta caves (Near Mumbai)

Hill stations

Mahabaleshwar, Panchgani, Lonavala, Khandala, Matheran,

Beaches

Ganapati pule, Alibagh, Murud, many more along the Konkan coast and Goa

Forts in Western Ghats

Sinhagad, Shivneri, Raigad, Rajgad, Murud-Janjira, etc.

Biodiversity hotspots

Kaas lake and plateau, Bhimashankar, Mahabaleshwar, Panchgani, Tamhinighat and entire Western ghats.

Historical places

Aurangabad, Satara, Kolhapur, Mumbai.

Pilgrimage sites

Trimbakeshwar, Nashik, Jejuri, Shirdi, Ashtavinayak temples, etc.
